Limited to 275 Riders – Mail In Pre-Registration Only – Ride is on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday  
Lunch on trail Saturday and Dinner on Saturday night provided with registration fee of **\$55.00**  
This is a RAIN OR SHINE RIDE – no refunds-no transfers-100% of Proceeds go to Northampton Fire & Rescue Co.

Trail Ride on beaches, in the bay, woods and fields. Porta-Potties & horse water provided. Campers welcome after 1:00 pm on Thursday, October 10, 2024 (porta potties will be available on Thursday). There is a hydrant of portable water but please plan to bring your own drinking water. No Horse Washing. This is primitive camping in fields and woods-no hook-ups, no electric. Please be courteous and use quiet generators and turn them off by 11pm.

**Thursday** after 1:00 pm - Take the Friday 3 mile short ride

**Friday** - 3 mile short ride or 7 mile long ride does NOT include the beach – Ride out anytime

**Saturday** - 15 mile ride, includes lunch on trail, beach and bay riding- Ride out time TBD

**Sunday** - 10 mile ride – ride out anytime but must be back by 3:00 pm - (includes beach and bay riding)

Well behaved Dogs are Welcome and must be on a 6' leash at all times while outside or securely contained in a dog fence. Any loose and/or aggressive dogs and owners may be asked to leave with no refund. **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON TRAILS OR IN THE PAVILION-NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON TRAILS FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL RIDERS AND HORSES**

No ponying, No Stallions – EVERYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN RIDING

**WATCH FOR LARGE "TRAIL RIDE" SIGNS ON HIGHWAYS**

Directions From South: Route 13 North from Virginia Beach to Machipongo, VA (about 18 miles north of Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnel) LEFT across Route 13 at Route 628 (Wilsonia Neck Road)-Immediate RIGHT on Route 618 (Bayside Road). Stay on BAYSIDE ROAD for about 5 miles (ignore changes in route #s) LEFT on Route 695 - (CEDAR GROVE FARM ROAD) – Right on SECOND dirt road to camp site.

Directions From North: Approximately 73 miles South of Salisbury, Maryland – just past Mile 99 RIGHT at LIGHT Route 604 (BAYSIDE ROAD-becomes Route 618 immediately-ignore route changes) stay on BAYSIDE ROAD for 7 miles – RIGHT on Route 695 (CEDAR GROVE FARM ROAD) – RIGHT on Second dirt road to camp site.

Your horse does not need shoes for this ride. The land is mostly flat but it is a 15 mile trail ride to the beach and back on Saturday.

Rules of the Ride: I understand additional ride information may be posted at the ride. I agree to respect all property and to follow trail markers (not hoof prints). I understand the trail may vary from previous years. I shall protect crops and property by staying on the trail and I am responsible for keeping my mount under control and not riding in the planted fields. I shall observe trail etiquette and will adhere to any instructions from outriders. I UNDERSTAND THAT SAFETY HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 and are recommended for all riders. No stallions, No ponying (leading another horse with or without a rider). No dogs on the trails. Parents must accompany and ride with all children under the age of 18 or Parent must release liability for children 16-18 not accompanied by a parent.

WAIVER: In consideration of being permitted to participate in this equine activity, the undersigned (Releasor) executes this Waiver and Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement (Release) and hereby agrees as follows: Releasor is aware of the risks of injury and death inherent in Equine Activity and acknowledges that (s)he has read the above Rules which are incorporated into and made part of this Release by this reference. Releasor hereby expressly assumes all risk associated with all such Equine Activity. Releasor hereby releases, waives and discharges Northampton County Fire and Rescue Company, its officers, members, directors, employees, all other persons or entities acting on its behalf and any and all landowners allowing the use of their land for this equine activity, and all participant organizers (collectively, the Releasees) from all liability to Releasor, and his or her spouse, legal representatives, heirs, successors and/or assigns, for any loss, injury or damage, and any and all claims therefore, on account of injury to Releasor's person or property, or the death of Releasor while Releasor is engaged in any equine activity. Releasor hereby waives his or her right to sue Releasees on account or injury to Releasor's person or property, or the death of Releasor while Releasor is engaged in equine activities. Releasor hereby indemnifies and agrees to hold harmless Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur due to Releasor's presence in, upon or around property being used by the organizers for the purpose of this equine activity, or due to Releasor's participation in such equine activity regardless of where such participation may occur. This release is governed by and shall be construed in accordance with Virginia Code: **§ 3.2-6202. Liability limited; liability actions**

**prohibited under the Virginia Code** A. Except as provided in § 3.2-6203, an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person, which shall include a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company, shall not be liable for an injury to or death of a participant resulting from the intrinsic dangers of equine activities and, except as provided in § 3.2-6203, no participant nor any participant's parent, guardian, or representative shall have or make any claim against or recover from any equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities. B. Except as provided in § 3.2-6203, no participant or parent or guardian of a participant who has knowingly executed a waiver of his rights to sue or agrees to assume all risks specifically enumerated under this subsection may maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional for an injury to or the death of a participant engaged in an equine activity. The waiver shall give notice to the participant of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities. The waiver shall remain valid unless expressly revoked in writing by the participant or parent or guardian of a minor.

EACH SIGNATURE IS AUTHENTIC (DO NOT SIGN FOR OTHERS) - It is understood that signatures are for camping, horse camping and for the trail ride on October 10th-13th 2024. RIDERS AND NON-RIDERS MUST SIGN WAIVER-IF YOU ENTER THE CAMPGROUND YOU MUST SIGN A WAIVER
